All artists in the Midwest are invited to enter the Anderson Museum of Art's 12th annual FIGURES OF SPEECH competitive exhibition.

This is your opportunity to turn classic figures of speech into memorable and interesting works of art. Below are just a few examples:

- Alliteration: "She sells seashells"
- Euphemisms: "A little thin on the top"
- Hyperboles: "I've told you a hundred times" or "It cost a billion dollars"
- Metaphors: "Heart of stone" or "The world is a stage"
- Oxymoron: "Jumbo shrimp" or "Small crowd"
- Simile: "Like peas in a pod" or "As wise as an owl"

JUDGING & AWARDS

Works for exhibition will be selected from digital entries, and awards will be selected from actual artwork. Cash and/or purchase awards will be made. Possible purchase awards will be added to AMOA's Permanent Collection. Awards will be given during the Artist's Reception on Friday, July 7, 2023.

Our judge this year is Larry Lawson. Lawson is a local Anderson artist and owner of Anderson Ironworks and Woodcraft Design. He earned a fine arts degree from Ball State University after leaving the Army and now pursues his passion for art full-time. Lawson is an author, sculptor, painter, ceramicist, and photographer.

SALE & REPRODUCTION RIGHTS

Sales are encouraged during the exhibition. AMOA will deduct a 30% commission on all sales made during the show. AMOA reserves the right to reproduce any of the works for publicity or catalogue purposes.

INSURANCE

All reasonable care is taken to prevent damage to works received. AMOA cannot accept responsibility for damage/loss to artwork during delivery or return. AMOA will insure works selected for exhibition during their public display. Works will be insured at market value or indicated insurance value. Maximum coverage for entry is \$2500.

ELIGIBILITY

FIGURES OF SPEECH is open to artists 18 years of age or older who currently or formerly created work in the Midwest states (IA, IL, IN, KS, MI, MN, MO, ND, NE, OH, SD, & WI).

The following media will be accepted:

Works on Paper

Paintings

Contemporary Conceptual Photography*

Mixed Media

Sculpture

*Contemporary conceptual photography is photography that is staged to represent an idea and is often manipulated digitally. It is often used to convey an emotion or imply something about a person or society.

Any work previously exhibited at AMOA is ineligible.

PRESENTATION

Works must be professionally presented and ready for installation upon delivery.

Works on paper must be matted and/or framed.

Sculptures can be no more than 50 pounds in weight.

Paintings and photography must be framed and/or have finished edges.

PROCEDURE FOR DIGITAL SUBMISSION

Artists can submit **up to three** entries online.

Please go to: **www.andersonart.org/figures-of-speech** to upload your photos, fill out an entry form, and to make your payment. Everything that you submit will be reviewed by an AMOA staff member and an email will be sent as soon as possible to confirm receipt. Online entries are preferred however, artists may provide a flash drive with images. Entry fee is nonrefundable.

Each artist can enter up to 3 works for a fee of \$30

Images should be 300 ppi, (1200 x 1800 pixels), JPEG file format

Up to 3 images per entry will be allowed with a total of 9

Included in the 9 images should be 1 detail image of each entry

Only 9 images will be viewed

Digital entries should be labeled in the following manner:

Last name_first initial #1 (or #2 correspond with entry form)_title

Example:

Smith_J1_Putting Down Roots Detail
Smith_J2_Birds of a Feather Flock Together

Accepted works not accurately represented by the submitted image will be withheld from the exhibition.
