Artists may enter works that showcase either **winter** (such as a snowy landscape, a polar bear sculpture, or an abstract snowflake painting) or a **holiday** (such as a portrait of a family lighting a Christmas tree, an oil painting of a menorah, or an intricate piece of jewelry inspired by Kwanzaa).

## ELIGIBILITY

This holiday and winter themed exhibit is open to artists 18 years of age or older.

The following mediums are accepted: paintings, photography, pottery, jewelry, mixed media, woodworking, and sculpture. Any artwork previously exhibited at AMOA is ineligible. Artwork must have been created in the past five years.

## CRITERIA

- Artwork must be professionally presented and ready for installation. 2D works must be ready to hang with a wire hanger. No sawtooth hangers please.
- Works on paper must be matted/and or framed.
- Gallery wrapped canvases are acceptable but they must be ready to hang.
- If a sculpture is more than 50 lbs in weight please contact us.
- Entries must be original and must not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted or published work.

## JUDGING & AWARDS

Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be awarded. The holiday and winter categories are combined. Awards will be given at the Opening Reception on Wednesday, November 15 from 5 - 7 pm. Judge to be announced soon.

## INSURANCE

All reasonable care is taken to prevent damage to works received. AMOA cannot accept responsibility for damages/loss to artwork during delivery or return. AMOA will insure works selected for exhibition during their public display. Works will be insured at market value or indicated insurance value. Maximum coverage for entry is \$2500.

## SALE & RIGHTS

Sales are encouraged during the exhibition. AMOA will deduct a 30% commission on all sales made during the show. AMOA reserves the right to reproduce any of the works for publicity or catalogue purposes.
