ABOUT

Artisans are invited to enter AMOA's 2nd textile/fiber competition and exhibition. AMOA will exhibit submissions that reflect a wide range of works related to the fiber medium. The goal of the exhibition is to include innovative work rooted in traditional fiber materials, structure, processes, and history, as well as art that explores unexpected relationships between fiber and other creative disciplines.

Artists are encouraged to include a statement about each of their individual pieces or a general statement about their work in fiber and textiles. Please attach your statement to the entry form or send it through email to smichaels@andersonart.org.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to work made with fiber or fiber techniques (including but not exclusive to quilting, sewing, knitting, crochet, tatting, weaving, spinning, felting, etc) or with mixed media elements that reference fiber or fiber traditions.
- All formats of fiber art will be considered, including wall-hung, free-standing, or pedestal mounted.
- Entries must have been made in the past 5 years.
- Entries must be original and must not be copied, derivatives, or based on other copyrighted or published work.
- All skill levels are welcome.
- Work must be ready to hang/install. This includes sleeve and pole for quilts and wires on frames – to be provided by the artist.
- Artists of wearable art and apparel entries are encouraged to provide means to display work if possible. The museum does not own mannequins.

SALES

Sales are encouraged during the exhibition. AMOA will deduct a 30% commission on all sales made during the show.

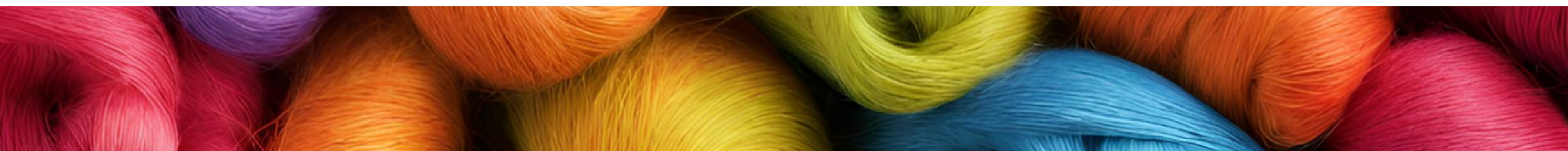
